What is truth?

1. What you believe to be true will determine how you behave.

Satan is the enemy of truth.
John 8:44

Satan will always question, confuse, and counterfeit truth.
Genesis 3:1-6

TRUE[ish] - A true[ish] belief is a belief that sounds true, looks true, or feels true but is actually a lie.
Romans 1:25

Relativism - There is no such thing as absolute truth.

Subjectivism - I (the subject) get to decide what I think is true.

2. Truth is not just a what, but a who.

Jesus is truth.
John 14:6, John 1:1, 14

Truth without grace leads to legalism.

Grace without truth leads to relativism and subjectivism.

3. You better seek it.

Deuteronomy 4:29, Proverbs 8:17, Jeremiah 29:13

God's **word** is truth.

John 17:17, Psalm 51:6

Why should I seek truth? Because the truth will set you **free**.
