

The PICTURE

- Matthew 26:26 – the “Last Supper” – Jesus and the disciples sharing the Jewish Passover feast.
- The Jewish Passover Feast is a beautiful picture of the GOSPEL.
- Ultimately, Jesus Christ Himself is our Passover. - 1 Corinthians 5:7
- The LORD'S SUPPER is NOT the Passover. The Lord's Supper does NOT represent the gospel.
- It is a MEMORIAL. We are to REMEMBER something. - 1 Corinthians 11:24-25
- We do that by sharing BREAD together. Similarly, we share a CUP together.
- This cup has “the fruit of the vine” / grape juice. Both elements must be unleavened. - Luke 12:1
- The Passover was held during the feast of Unleavened Bread.

The PURPOSE

- The ultimate purpose is FELLOWSHIP with the Lord.
1 Corinthians 10:16

- The Church is given TWO ORDINANCES:

Baptism – is associated with the GREAT COMMISSION
Matthew 28:19-20

Lord's Supper – is associated with the GREAT COMMAND-
MENT
Matthew 22:36-40

- Loving other people is the sign of true Salvation:
1 John 3:14

- Loving other people is the sign of true Discipleship:
John 13:35

THE KEY lesson from that Last Supper: FOOT WASHING

John 13

v.7 it is symbolic

v.8 it is about FELLOWSHIP with Jesus

1 Samuel 30:24; Revelation 22:19

The COMMAND for us: ye OUGHT to wash one another's feet!
John 13:14

He is asking us to go to one another and FORGIVE!

“A man who can keep SHORT ACCOUNTS with God is WORTHY to fellowship with Him at His table.”

- WHO IS GUILTY?
1 Corinthians 11:29
